

## Examination and Academic Development Committee Annual Report- 2020-21

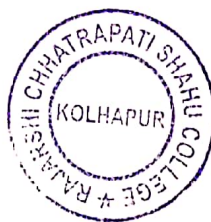
The Institution prepares an examination schedule which is incorporated in Academic Calendar. The Institution has offered B.A., B.COM, B.Sc., BCS, MA and M.Sc. programmes to the students. IQAC and Examination and Academic Development Committee of the institution has prepared annual calendar for conducting various internal evaluation examination. This allows the teachers to preplan the assessment procedures to be employed for each class. The schedule includes home assignments, unit tests, pre-semester examination, mid-term examination, tutorial, GDs, MCQs. The unit tests were organized at the Department level. The internal evaluation is done as per the rubrics devised by the committee.

However, due to the corona pandemic situation excluding March 2021 teaching and evaluation process was done through online mode. All departments have taken online unit tests whereas institution has conducted online preliminary examination for the students at the end of July- August 2021 for all programmes. The examination of the 1<sup>st</sup> year students for the semester I and II are taken at institutional level and results were communicated to the University. As per Shivaji University's notification, the institution has also taken offline examination of students who were unable to give online examination for the Semester III, IV, V and VI and results of the same is communicated to the University for Further Process. The results of internal evaluation, i.e. Term Work, were prepared only for the last year student which is a part of University Examination. There is a provision of eight Additional Credits for the students while completing his/her degree course. The study material for these credits is available on University website but the examinations of Civic Courses (Non-CGPA) - twice in a year for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year students -were also conducted through online mode and results are communicated to the university within a stipulated period. For internal examination centralized seating arrangement was made and block-wise examination is conducted. Choice Based Credit System has introduced for PG courses by University has helped to test communication skills of the students. Our institution followed the university norms and guidelines for conducting semester examinations. College had appointed junior supervisor senior supervisors and guided them for their work. It is significant to note here that during the Pandemic situation of Covid-19, the Institution has taken Pre-Semester Examination through online mode for the students of all programmes in the month of July-August-2021. The results of final year students of University Examination were remarkable. The pass percentage of M.Sc.-II., M.A.II and BCS-III were 100 per cent whereas the pass percentage of B.Sc.-III students was 98.55 per cent. The pass percentage of B.A.-III students was 87.93 per cent and of B.Com.-III was 95.16 per cent whereas the pass percentage of B.A.-III was 87.93 per cent.
