Rayat Shikshan Sanstha, the mother Institute of Rajarshi Chhatarapati Shahu College, Kolhapur was established by late Padmabhushan Dr. Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil in the year 1919 is one of the leading institutions in Asia. The Sanstha has celebrated its centenary year in 2019.
