Marginality, a major concern in socio-cultural, economic and political spheres, is the focus of this webinar. Dr.S.m.Sathe ,Head,Department of English welcomed all the participants and explained the purpose behind the webinar. The webinar was inaugurated at the hands of Dr.A.M. Sarwade Head, Dept of English, Shivaji University, Kolhapur. 


